The contestants sped up their actions to make finishing touches while the crowd intensified their supportive cheer at the countdown to the last five minutes of the competition.


The panel of judges later reviewed the artworks and gave their scores based on elements of theme resemblance, creativity and originality, colour combination and overall presentation.
